ABOUT THE ARTIST

Minju Kang's artistic practice centers on an intuitive and introspective approach to painting, where she explores the interplay between conscious and unconscious thoughts. She allows her subconscious feelings to guide her creative process, letting images and visions emerge naturally rather than deliberately pursuing a specific outcome. Her work navigates the delicate boundary between reality and unreality, often using ambiguous or paradoxical arrangements to blur the lines between the two. Through this, she aims to evoke a sense of confusion in viewers, encouraging them to pause, reflect, and find personal meaning and comfort in her work. Ultimately, Kang's art serves as a visual manifestation of her inner world, capturing fleeting emotions and memories that reside beyond conscious awareness.
